

## CLASS SUPPLY LIST

### Beginning Quilting: 4-Patch (single, double & disappearing)

Whether you're renewing your love of quilting, or making a quilt for the first time, retired high school sewing instructor Jayne Vetter will guide you to success.

**Project:** Choose from making a Pillow Cover, Place Mat, Wall Hanging, Table Runner or begin a quilt top. In Jayne's class, you'll learn the basic quilt making skills! You will go step-by-step through quilt design, rotary cutting, piecing, seaming and pressing, quilt layer assembly, machine quilting and adding binding, for impressive results.

**Skill Level:** This class is for the confident beginner, familiar with their sewing machine, new to quilting, or simply wants a refresher while learning new techniques.

**DAY 1:** Construct a sample 4-Patch double/disappearing block, address seam allowance, stitch length, pressing and rotary cutting. Cut out blocks for project. Start construction of blocks. **Homework:** Finish sewing 4-8 blocks.

**DAY 2:** Assemble blocks, add optional sashing and/or borders, machine quilt & machine bind.
