Sewing Machine in working condition

Must know how to use your sewing machine and wind a bobbin

Fabric to Purchase for making a Runner

** 6 fat quarters of six different fabrics

½ yd border fabric

7/8 yd backing fabric

1/3 yd binding fabric

Crib size batting (required 18 ½" x 54 ½")

OR you can do

Fabric to Purchase for 40" x 40" Sampler Quilt (if you're a fast learner)

1 Yard for outer border (This will be your focal fabric)

1/3 Yard each for 3-4 different green fabrics

1/3 Yard each for 3-4 different red fabrics

1/3 Yard each for 2 different neutral fabrics

1/3 Yard each for medium to dark neutral fabrics

*¼ Yard for Plaid Inner Border

*3/8 Yard for Binding

*1 ¼ Yard for Backing

*42" x 42" Batting (Warm & Natural, Warm & White or 100% Cotton)

**Machine Accessories

Machine (Don't forget your pedal and electrical cord)

Machine Needles: Quilting 90/14 (uses 40 weight thread)

Machine Thread: Neutral color (white, black, light grey)

1/4" Foot guided

Open toe foot (optional)

Walking Foot

Zipper Foot (optional)

Quilting Tools:

**Basic sewing tools

Curved Safety pins for Machine Quilting

**Quilting Pins (extra fine .04mm, glass head pins) (in kit)

**Seam Ripper

Stiletto/awl

**Measuring Gauge (in kit)

**Small Scissors or snips

**Marking pen (will go over different brands in class)

**Rotary cutter (45mm)

Rotary Mat (10 x 10 or 12 x 12) used by sewing machine to cut loose threads
