## What you need to know in advance:

- How to use your sewing machine and Some sewing experience (minimum 2 hours)
- Recommended: to take Beginning Sewing Level 1 prior to Level 2.

## Supplies and notions list:

- Sewing machine needles and bobbins
- Sewing thread
- Woven fabric yardage (cotton plain weave or flannel is recommended) as pattern calls for
- 1 ½ yards ¾" wide elastic
- Sewing scissors
- Paper scissors
- A rotary cutter and self-healing cutting mat (optional)
- A measuring tape
- A clear ruler
- Sharp sewing pins
- A seam gauge
- A marking pen or pencil (water-soluble, chalk, Frixion erasable)
- A seam ripper
