

✦ Tools

- Sewing machine in good working order with a free arm
- Walking foot (very helpful with foam)
- Jeans/denim needle (size 90/14 or 100/16)
- Rotary cutter, mat, and ruler
- Iron + pressing surface and parchment paper or Teflon ironing sheet
- Scissors or snips

Supplies: (optional 1/8" poly plumbers tubing (this will give handles added structure))

Aunties Two Giant Poppins Bag pattern. 2 metal stays are included in the purchase.



GIANT POPPINS BAG

Big zipper top bag. Six pockets on the inside to keep everything organized.

Large enough for a large sewing machine. Unlike our other Poppins bags, the bottom on this bag is sewn on by machine!!!

Directions are given for non-directional print fabric. Fabric with a directional print or panels may require more fabric for the inside pockets (see inside front cover and page 13)

FABRIC A Outside (Non-directional fabric with 42" of usable width)

Bag Body, Side Binding, Inside Pockets and Pocket Lining **2 yards**

*For directional print fabric or panels, you will need enough fabric to cut the following
2 rectangles 21" tall x 34" wide*

If fussy cutting panels, you may need 2 panels. See inside front cover and page 13 for layout suggestions and changes to fabric requirements for various panels

FABRIC B Inside (Non-directional fabric)

Bag Body Lining **1 yard**

(If using a directional print or panel Fabric A, you may 1 additional yard of Fabric B)

FABRIC C Finishing (Non-directional fabric)

Handles, Bottom, Binding, Bows, Tabs **1½ yards**

INTERFACING

Bag Body: Bosal's IN-R-FORM PLUS (#493) - **2 yards**

IN-R-FORM PLUS is a double-sided fusible foam batting

Bottoms: Bosal's CRAFTTEX PLUS (30" wide) **1 yard**

CRAFTTEX PLUS is a double-sided fusible stiff interfacing

OR use Bosal's pre-cut CraftTex Plus GIANT Poppins Bag Bottoms (#437-GP)

ZIPPER 36" Handbag Zipper with a wide zipper tape and double slides

Available online from wingspancrafts.com

STAYS 2 Stays included with the pattern. Use two stays per bag.

Stays (Size A) also sold separately by Aunties Two #AT646
