

Sew Knits w/Jayne

Sew a simple knit fabric project. Learn the basics of choosing the right fabric and pattern, to special construction techniques that knit fabrics demand. Learn how to read a commercial pattern, follow a cutting layout, and apply knit sewing techniques with or without a Serger. All you need is a good working sewing machine with stretch stitch and/or zig zag stitch to replicate the commercial serged seam. Complete samples that include basic seaming, stabilizing, neck & edge finishes, & hemming. By the end of the class, you'll have Incorporated these techniques into your chosen simple knit sewing project!

Homework: Finishing any work not completed during class time.

Skill Level: This class is for the confident beginner who is comfortable with the operation of their sewing machine. **Recommended Prerequisite:** Beginning Sewing 1 w/Jayne

| Project Materials (Discussed session 1, due session 2) |

| COMMERCIAL PATTERN: Designed for Knit fabrics, if you have a pattern, you think is similar to a pattern on the suggested list bring it with you to session 1 for teacher approval. |
| KNIT or STRETCH WOVEN FABRIC: pre-washed & pressed according to fiber content |
| Knit fusible tricot INTERFACING: Depends on pattern & type of knit fabric |
| Polyester all-purpose THREAD: Any color for 1 st session, match project for sessions 2-4. |
| NOTIONS: Identified in chosen pattern such as elastic, bias tape, buttons, zipper, etc. |




Hudson Pant by True/Bias (Sold at Montavilla Sewing Center)


Stretch - For knits with two-way stretch particularly those containing Lycra™, rubber in swim wear and lingerie, and for sewing elastic. Use with texturized nylon or polyester thread. Specially designed scarf prevents skipped stitches. Available in sizes: 75/11, 90/14.



Ball Point - For cotton knits, interlock rib knits, fleece, double knit, Ultrasuede™, and most other knit fabrics. Use with polyester or lightweight cotton thread (50 wt). Ballpoint tip prevents needle from piercing and breaking fibers. Available in sizes: 70/10, 80/12, 90/14.



Twin - For heirloom sewing and decorative top-stitching. Use with cotton, polyester and rayon embroidery thread. Size indicates distance between needles. Twin available in Ballpoint, Universal, Jeans, Embroidery, Metallic and Stretch in a variety of sizes. Twin needles are fixed in a nylon block and should be used at slower speeds and not for prolonged periods.
