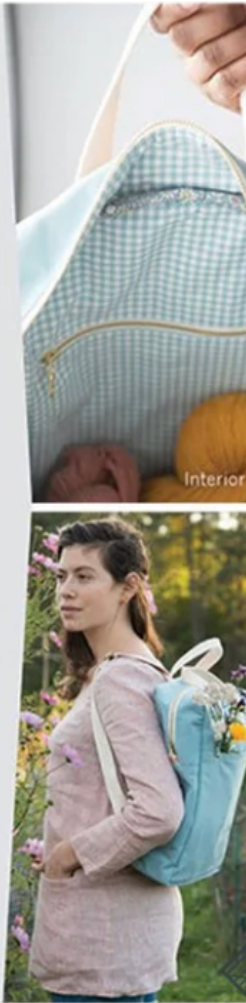


Supplies:

+ Requirements based on 44"-wide fabric.

Exterior Fabric	1 yard (1 m)
Lining Fabric	1 yard (1 m)
Fusible Woven Interfacing (Pellon SF101 - 20"-wide)	2 yards (1.8 m)
Medium Weight Fusible Interfacing (Pellon 809 - 42"-wide)^	1 yard (1 m)
Foam Stabilizer (ByAnnie's or 1 yard (1 m) Pellon Flex-Foam) ^	½ yard (0.4 m)
(2) 1 ½" (3.8 cm) wide rectangle rings & (2) 1 ½" (3.8 cm) wide strap sliders	
(1) 22" (55 cm) zipper for top closure	
(1) 8" (20 cm) zipper for interior zip pocket	
1 1/8 yards (1 m) of 1" (2.5 cm) wide cotton or poly webbing for top handles	
2 ½ yards (2.3 m) of 1 ½" (3.8 cm) wide cotton or poly webbing for straps	
3 ½ yards (3.2 m) straight-grain ½" (1.3 cm) wide double fold binding	
Recommended Fabrics: canvas (7-9 oz. weight) or waxed canvas (10-12 oz. weight) for exterior fabric, quilting cotton for lining fabric	
^ =omit if using waxed canvas	
Additional supplies + tools: Polyester thread, water-soluble pen or tailor's chalk, cutting mat, ruler, rotary cutter, size 90/14 or 100/16 Denim or Microtex needle, (Optional) 2¼" wide x 1 ½" tall (5.7 cm x 3.8 cm) piece of leather for patch, (Optional) 2 rivets - 8-9 mm head with 6-8 mm posts (and corresponding setting tool), (Optional) front pocket closure (see pg. 4 note) 14mm magnetic snap or size 24 metal snap

a simple backpack with interior zip pocket and front pocket



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#5 Coil

¼ yd fabric (cut 3 cross-grain - 2 ½" strips for binding)

*Pellon Shape Flex 101 or other woven cotton fusible stabilizer. **I used Décor Bond *** ½ yd. Bosal double-sided Fusible. Fusible foam is especially nice if you want to quilt the foam to exterior fabric. I quilted cork and foam for exterior front & back panels.

Optional: ½ yd. Mesh & ½ yd. ¾" wide Fold-over elastic for additional interior pocket.



MAKER'S TOTE a carry-all tote in two sizes



Supplies:

+ Requirements based on 44"-wide fabric.

Exterior Fabric	5/8 yard (1/2 yard)
Lining Fabric	1 1/4 yards (1 yard)
Pocket Fabric	1 1/4 yards (1 yard)
Accent Fabric (includes binding and handles)	1/2 yard
Fusible Woven Interfacing (Pellon SF101 - 20"-wide)	1 1/2 yards
Fusible Mid-weight Interfacing (Pellon 809 - 44" wide)	1 yard
ByAnnie's Soft and Stable (or Pellon FlexFoam -20" wide)	1/2 yard or 1 yard of Pellon
18" separating "Jacket" zipper (14" for small)***	
10" non-separating zipper for tote back (7" for small)	
Recommended Fabrics: Cotton Canvas, cotton/linen canvas, denim, twill, home dec or quilting cotton for exterior. Quilting cotton for lining and pockets.	
Additional supplies + tools: Thread, water-soluble pen, cutting mat, ruler, rotary cutter, turning tool, (2) 1/4" x 5" strips of leather/ribbon for zipper pull(s), denim needle, (1) size 24 pronged metal snap set, *** = can substitute 2-3 additional sets of snaps if not installing zipper, snap setting tool, binder clips, pinking shears, washable fabric glue stick, 25mm bias tape maker, 1/4"-wide fusible web tape, cardstock or template plastic

1 FQ Omit covering handles

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#5 Coil

* Pellon Shape Flex 101 or other woven cotton fusible stabilizer. ** I used Décor Bond *** 1/2 yd. Bosal double-sided Fusible.
