## Men's Button-up Shirt

## **Supply List**

All supplies can be purchased at Montavilla Sewing Center with a 15% discount, excluding the pattern (link below).

Items with stars\* are needed for first day of class.

We will talk in the first class about the variety of fabrics you can use to make this shirt. If you want to wait to buy your shirt fabric until after the 1st class, please do so. We will discuss how much yardage will be needed as well as pre-washing methods. *Again*, you will not need the shirt fabric until the second class.

- \*Burda pattern #6349 (<a href="https://simplicity.com/burda-style/bur6349">https://simplicity.com/burda-style/bur6349</a>)
- \*2-4 yards Pattern Ease (for tracing your pattern)
- \*3 yards Muslin (bleached or unbleached)
- 3 yards fabric for shirt. (Unless you want to have a different yoke and collar: 2 1/4 yards of main fabric and 3/4 yards of contrasting fabric). Will will be discussing this at the end of the first class.
- 1/2 yard of interfacing (we will be discussing different types of interfacing in the first class).
- 7 buttons (11mm/~3/8")
- 1 spool 50wt polyester bright colored thread for sewing muslin shirt.
- 1-2 spools 50wt polyester matching or contrasting thread for shirt.
- Scissors (7"-12" and sharp!) and Rotary cutter (28m). This smaller rotary cutter is easier to cut curves.
- Fine pins

- Seam Guide
- Hand needles

Garment ruler 2x18

Marking Tools, like chalk and heat away pens

Pattern weights

Sewing machine and Serger. We will have a classroom serger available to use.
