

PIN CUSHION DOLL – CLASS SUPPLY LIST

The class will introduce you to making cloth dolls. You'll be guided through making doll body, arms, head, face and hair. I'll share tips for stitching the little hands with ease. You'll accessorize her with you own personal touches.

DOLL PATTERN KIT INCLUDES:

- Traceable pattern and instructions
- 1/8 Wood base and dowel (internal structure)
- Pipe cleaner (internal support for arms)
- Plastic template sheet for tracing pattern pieces
- Small piece of skin tone fabric for face and hands

DOLL CLASS SUPPLIES TO BRING TO CLASS:

- 1 or 2 fat quarters or quarter yard pieces of fabrics for doll bottom skirt
- Small scraps of fabric to coordinate doll arms and bodice
- 18 inches of coordinating ribbon for apron and hair tie
- Scrap of quilt batting or thick fleece for the needle holder
- Worsted yarn and/or eyelash yarn for doll hair
- Stuffing - Poly Fill
- Tiny buttons, Lace, beads and trims as desired to accessorize the doll

TOOLS TO BRING TO CLASS (*I will also share my tools during class*):

- Sewing machine (no fancy stitching needed just straight stitches)
- Usual sewing notions (hand sewing needles, sewing machine thread, pins, scissors, etc.)
- Long or medium doll needle (for sculpting face and attaching arms)
- Strong thread for hand stitching & sculpting face (hand quilting or upholstery thread)
- Disappearing marking pens – air soluble
- Turning tools (Quick Turn Tools)
- Stuffing tool (chop sticks work & hemostats work the best found in quilting notions)
- Frey Check
- Pigma pen or extra fine line permanent marker
- Prismacolor pencils fine art color pencils

WHAT TO DO BEFORE CLASS:

- Make sure your sewing machine is in good working order
- Select your fabrics, trims, ribbon and yarn for hair. Consider scraps from other projects. It's a good idea to bring extra fabric choices for flexibility & creativity in your design.
