

Jean Rope Bowl

No prior experience is necessary – this class is suitable for beginners and experienced crafters alike but attendees must have basic sewing mastery and bring a functional sewing machine that has the capability of sewing a wide zig zag stitch.

Supply List:

Sewing Machine

Clear or open toe pressure foot

Denim machine needles

1 yard lightweight Denim Fabric cut into 1” strips on the bias.

If you are unsure how to cut on the bias please watch this video: Make sure to only cut strips to 1” for our purpose.

¼ yard contrasting or matching cotton fabric (optional)

1- 34” jean waistband including belt keepers removed from jeans and 1 – jeans pocket removed from jeans.

* You can use a smaller waist size just know that the finished bowl will be smaller than the example

If you do not know how to remove waistband watch this video ... Please use a seam ripper and not a knife!

Thread and bobbin to match jeans. You will need approximately 3 bobbin spools. Poly or cotton ok.

100-foot cotton clothesline-removed from packaging and rolled into a ball
(You can find these easily at Amazon, Walmart, or Bi-Mart) You want the rope to be 1/4 in or 3/16 in diameter and fairly stiff. If it is too soft the bowl will not hold its shape well.
