

Supply List for the Small Camden Bag:

- **Aunties Two Pattern AT285**
- **Fabric strips: 16 strips (2½" wide x 44" long) in assorted prints or coordinating colors**
 - Heavy-duty fusible interfacing (e.g., Bosal In-R-Form or equivalent), A good option is Duet Fuse II by BOSAL(available at Montavilla Stores)
- **Side Binding:**
 - 3 fabric strips 2 ½ " x 44" wide
 - Cut two stiff double-sided interfacing rectangles (Pellon 72F) @ 10" x 15" OR use Bosal's new small precut Camden bag bottoms.(Available at Amazon or check your Montavilla stores)
- **Bottom:**
 - 2 fabric panels 10" x 15"
- **Bottom Binding:**
 - 2 fabric strips 1 ¼ " x 44"
- **Handles:**
 - 2 fabric strips 4" x 22"
 - Peltex 72F or Craf-tex plus for handle structure (2) pieces 1 ¾ "x 26 ½"
 - 2 pieces @ 21" of 1/4" polyethylene plumbing tubing (I will have some available in class) You can purchase this at home depot by the foot or from amazon.
- **Thread:**
 - 50 wt polyester for machine stitching
 - 12 wt cotton for hand stitching the base and buttons to match your fabric
- **Needles:**
 - 90/14 Microtex Sharp for straight stitching
- **Buttons: Large and small for decorative layering(optional)**
- **Tools & Notions:**
 - Sewing Machine with straight and zigzag stitch
 - Sewing clips
 - Pins
 - Frixion or chalk marker
 - Rotary cutter
 - Quilting ruler (6" x 24")
 - Turning tool (optional)
 - Scissors (fabric + thread)
 - Seam ripper
 - Large-eyed needle (Milliner's size 7)
 - Quilting bar foot (optional for even spacing)
