Learn Your Serger: Levels 1 & 2



- 1. Your serger, power cord, foot control, all accessories and the manual. **If you don't have the manual, please download and print one from the internet.** It is a great resource. Be sure to bring the tool that allows you to change the needle. It is either a tiny flathead screwdriver or a tiny Allen wrench. If you don't have it, try to replace it before class.
- 2. 4 spools of thread in 4 different colors. You can use regular spool thread if you don't have cones. If you want to follow the samples just as I will demo, bring green, blue, yellow, red--as long as the colors are contrasting, so you can really differentiate between them.
- 3. Standard sewing supplies (scissors, seam gauge, pins etc.)
- 4. Long tweezers (these come with every new serger, but if yours has wandered off, please be sure you bring one!) They are your best friend when threading a serger!
- 5. Double-sided tape for securing samples in your notebook. Pins work, too!
- 6. Covered water bottle. Snack. We will break for about 20 minutes.
