Quilting Project: TOOL KEEPER

Learn all the components of making a quilt on a much smaller scale. Techniques covered include rotary cutting, strip piecing, seaming & pressing. Incorporate your sewing machine decorative stitches as quilting. Finish with binding.

Skill Level: This class is for the confident beginner, familiar with the sewing machine, new to quilting, or simply wants a refresher and/or to learn a different approach.

(Small) 13" x 15", (Large) 21"x17.5"

Sewing Tools
Working Sewing Machine Decorative stitch feet Optional: ¼" presser foot
Rotary Cutter & ruler
Optional: Small iron & press mat
Thread Snips or Scissors
Seam Ripper
Pins and/or Clips
Sewing Gauge

Tool keeper Materials (pre-cut fabric prior to class)	Small 13" x 15" (open)	Large 21"x17.5" (open)
Amounts will need to be adjusted if you choose to adjust the finished size of your TOOL keeper.		
Woven Cotton Fabric Strips	8 (2"x22")	11 (2 ½"x18.5")
Lining Fabric (inside) I prefer a solid to show off decorative stitches	1 fat quarter	2 fat quarters (pocket & lining)
Binding Fabric	2 - 2 ¼" WOF (1/8 yd.)	3 - 2 ¼" WOF (1/4 yd.)
Single or double-Sided Fusible Foam Stabilizer	13" x 21"	21" x 17.5"
All Purpose Thread is good for the construction. You may use assorted colors of All-purpose and/or Machine Embroidery thread. Thread will be used for visible decorative quilting & stitching binding.		
Closure options:	1 Button & 1 elastic hair band	45" of ½" - ¾" wide twill or satin trim
